What would your participation involve?

First Interview

After the Interview

After the first interview, we will ask the entire family to take photos of the people, places or things that represent your daily life and experience with respite care. Cameras will be provided to those who need one.

Second Interview

In the second interview, we will meet with the entire family, including the child using respite care and siblings, to discuss the photographs you took.

Participants will receive a gift card in appreciation of their time.

Your participation is completely voluntary. You can withdraw at any time.
